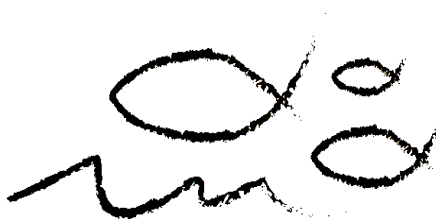

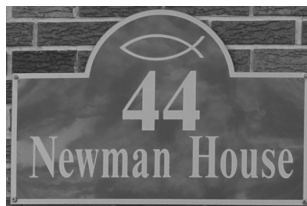
### **Please Support Our *Alternative Winter Break Trip***
